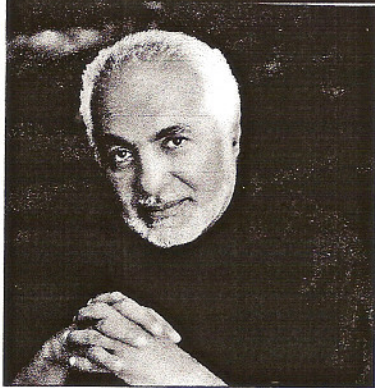

“ A Search for Meaning: A New Vision for Muslims and the West ”



As Imam of Masjid al-Farah, a mosque located twelve blocks from Ground Zero in New York City, he preaches a message of understanding between people of all creeds. He and his wife, Daisy Khan, were part of a group that set to build a Muslim community center in Lower Manhattan, a plan that morphed in 2010 into a heated national controversy about Sept. 11, Islam and freedom of religion. Mayor Bloomberg of NY supported the project.

Rauf has appeared regularly at the Council on Foreign Relations and the World Economic Forum (Davos). He has been interviewed by leading print media, including BBC, CNN, New York Times, Washington Post, Frontline, and Foreign Policy. His publications include, *Islam: A Search for Meaning*, *Islam: A New Vision for Muslims and the West*, which the Christian Science Monitor rated among its five best books of 2004; as well as articles such as “the Search for the Common Good” (with Rev. Dr. William Schulz in *Pursuing the Global Common Good*, 2007).
